How the Year 7 Catch-Up Premium was spent in 2017 – 2018

Objectives

To ensure good or better attainment in English and Maths for children in Year 7

Summary of Spending

Allocated time for English and Maths leads to ensure interventions are in place for pupils identified and to support the staff teaching in order to raise attainment.

Introduction of SumDog as a teaching and consolidation tool. Inter and Intra school competitions run to encourage Maths in year 7, pupils won the competition across the County.

Write dance training for English lead, to ensure pupils have a holistic approach to learning to write.

Interventions Used

Small group interventions and maths specialists teaching in year 7. English specialist taught year 7.

Use of specific schemes such as Rapid Reading to promote progress in reading.
