Objectives

To ensure good or better attainment in English and Maths for children in Year 7

Summary of Spending

The Year 7 Catch-Up grant was spent on bespoke interventions and targeted teaching to ensure that the pupils were making good or better progress.

Write dance was continued and talk for writing training attended and rolled out to support the gaps in writing.

In maths the pupils used SumDog and Conquer Maths as specific support for number and measure.

Lessons continued to be taught by subject specialists at year 7, rather than a class teacher.

Interventions Used

Individualised interventions.

Dockside English, Rapid Reading.

Maths interventions using SumDog as an incentive as well as Conquer Maths.
