Young Person Spotlight

Dan was supported by Kim (Social worker) and Adam (Housing Officer) to move into shared accommodation after he returned from residential college. Dan enjoys Rugby, playing for Worcester Wanderers a mixed ability rugby team based at Worcester Warriors

Dan goes to Wildgoose training three days a week, where he works with the animals. Dan's aim is to work at Pets at Home or at Curry's. He would like to have a pet snake.

Housing

The Positive Living Options Team are working with people who want to become more independent and live in accommodation that supports this.

This includes;

- 1) Cluster Flats scheme:
Where people have their own flat, within a cluster of other flats and have access to support over the 24hour period from both the on-site care provider and other care providers.
- 2) Shared accommodation:
Where people share a property with others. Having their own bedroom and where possible bathroom, and sharing communal space.

There are two new cluster flats schemes opening over the next two months, one in Evesham and one in Worcester.
