Commentary

CAG – Due to the COVID-19 pandemic Centre Assessed Grades (CAG) were used for the 2019/20 & 2020/21 summer series of qualifications. Therefore the 2018/19 results were the last set of pre-pandemic data.

English – Following a review of accredited courses in 2020 it was decided to change course from Edexcel Functional Skills English to WJEC Entry Level English. This was considered most appropriate for our current cohort of learners.

Maths – A new maths lead started in September 2019 and performed a review of the external maths accreditation. As a result of this it was decided to move from Edexcel Functional Skills Maths to AQA Entry Level Certificate Maths. Due to the impact of COVID-19 on teaching and learning, no learners were able to be entered for a Level 1 qualification during this time.

ICT – Due to the COVID-19 pandemic both Years 10 & 11 were entered for the Edexcel Functional Skills ICT qualification in 2020. As a result no students were entered in 2020/21.

Vocational Subjects/Skills for Living & Work – When the accredited curriculum was reviewed in 2020 it was decided to centralise the vocational offers within an umbrella qualification – Skills for Living & Work. The rationale was to allow our young people a wide range of different subjects which they could combine into a single qualification. It also allowed progression from KS4 into KS5 with the opportunity to achieve a certificate or diploma.
