The engagement and enjoyment of all pupils to take part in regular physical activity – both during curricular activities and extra-curricular activities</p>	<p>New equipment and resources to enhance the teaching and delivery of PE lessons and also unstructured times such as lunch times and after school clubs.</p>	<p>£400</p>	<p>Rigby Hall school staff now have the correct and suitable equipment for teaching PE lessons across the school. This has increased the level of teaching and impact on the children as they are receiving good quality teaching.</p> <p>External coaches that come in to teach Primary classes use our school's equipment too, so they are not having to bring their own equipment in every lesson.</p>	<p>Students to be able to access equipment and resources for not only curricular PE sessions but also access specific equipment just for lunch times and after school clubs.</p>

Increased confidence, knowledge and skills for all staff in teaching PE across the whole school.</p>	<p>Employ primary sports coaches 1/2 lessons a week to work alongside primary teachers to share teaching ideas and skills with each other and teachers across the school. Develop high quality teaching and learning for all students across the school regardless of their age or ability.</p>	<p>£10,000</p>	<p>Rigby Hall staff are getting the opportunity to observe and work alongside professional coaches teaching specialised sports such as rugby and tennis.</p> <p>Staff are able to observe how to teach the fundamental skills of some sports and are learning the sequence of skills to teach each week which build on the skills learnt the previous week.</p>	<p>Class teachers to feel confident in teaching PE across the school. Teachers can learn and share ideas with other teachers across the school.</p>

Continue this forward to next academic year.</p>	<p>Train more staff to teach different sports and activities across the school.</p>

<p>4. Increased participation in competitive sport</p>	<p>Working with other schools and the community to take part in competitions and festivals. Continue membership with the All active academy in order to participate in sporting events in the community. Ensure all ages of children get the opportunity to take part in these events.</p>	<p>£200</p>	<p>As a school, we have attended more competitions/events this academic year than any other year. Children are getting the opportunity to experience sport in a friendly and competitive way in the local community. Every key stage has experienced a sporting event except Rec/Key stage 1. We are hoping for them to attend an event in June. KS3 children are now going to Bromsgrove Hockey club every Monday to take part in Hockey lessons and competitions. We are hoping to extend this to KS2 pupils next year so they get to experience going to a club to learn Hockey skills.</p>	<p>Membership with All active Academy to continue this academic year. Ensure all ages and abilities of children get the opportunity to take part in these events.</p>
<p>5. CPD for PE coordinator</p>	<p>CPD training for PE coordinator to pass on skills and knowledge to other teachers in the school. Share resources with all teachers.</p>	<p>£300</p>	<p>The PE coordinator has attended several courses over the academic year such as, swimming teacher training, Active Maths and literacy, Change 4 life course and all of the PE coordinator courses. They have passed information and resources onto other staff members across the school.</p>	<p>Class teachers to feel confident in teaching PE across the school. PE Coordinator can learn and share ideas with other teachers across the school. This will enable more staff to teach different sports and activities across the school and have a large bank of ideas and resources to use.</p>
<p>6. Maths of the day membership</p>	<p>Sign up to Maths of the day membership. All teachers can access this website to find and download lesson plans for teaching active Maths across the curriculum for Primary students.</p>	<p>£450</p>	<p>The school has a membership with Maths of the day which every teacher across the school has an account for. Lesson Plans and resources are on the website to encourage Maths lessons to not just take part in the classroom but to be more active outside, in the gym or in the school hall. It also gives an alternative to using worksheets in lessons by giving practical ways of teaching different areas of Maths.</p>	<p>Teachers can benefit from this membership when teaching PE and Maths. Login can be used by all teachers in the school. Each area of the Maths curriculum is on the website and has a list of lesson plans and resources to be downloaded easily then shared by all</p>

<p>7. Stress monkeys</p>	<p>Stress monkeys is a new activity which children who feel stressed and anxious at school or home can access. A trained professional comes into school to do lots of fun activities to help with children's worries.</p>	<p>£500</p>	<p>We have had x2 children work alongside Liam Joe from Stress monkeys. We carefully selected these children as they required a lot of support to help manage their anger and anxieties. The 2 boys formed really positive relationships with Liam Joe and really started to trust him. We continued this for 2 terms and the results were incredible. Teachers of these 2 children gave really positive feedback and commented that they have seen some significant changes to their behaviour and the way they manage their own feelings in the classroom. Liam has used his experience with Rigby Hall to write a book on how to manage anger and anxieties in schools.</p> <p>Unfortunately due to Liam Joe's busy schedule, he is no longer able to continue working with Rigby hall school this academic year. He has assured us, he will definitely work with us again in the near future though.</p>	<p>Inquire about a member of staff coming in to help with children's worries and stresses. If children enjoy and stress monkeys is successful see if they can continue to come into school on a half termly or termly basis.</p>
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
