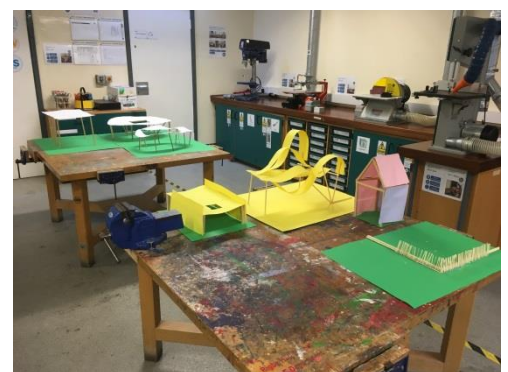
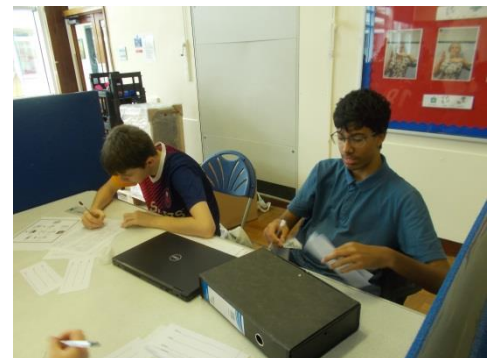
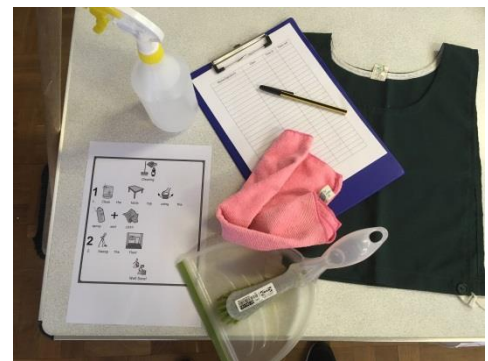
Rigby Hall has launched their expanded careers programme through an exciting 'Careers World' day at school. Students from key stage 3 & 4 have been able to try out a number of different jobs which they may be interested in. These included delivering parcels, reporting news stories, being part of a cleaning company, dog walking, catering, theatrical make up/salon and constructing and designing buildings.

Key stage 5 students were responsible for running some of the activities including the shop and bank, they encouraged other students to sign in/out of each work station and fill in a form of information. For each job the students earned 'Careers World' currency (Notezo) which they were able to save and then spend in the 'Careers World' shop.

During the session students soon realized that the more work they completed, the more money they earned. This proved to be extremely motivating for students, particularly those who are often difficult to engage. The feedback from students was extremely positive which many asking when they could repeat the experience. The model is going to be used with different job opportunities in the future and is suitable with some adjustments across the age range from primary up to school leavers.
