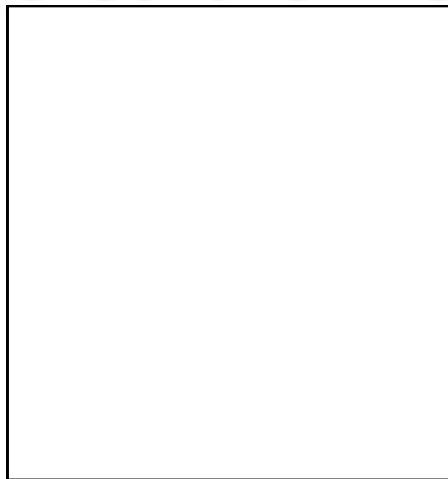

Business arising from the minutes.

**(Mr Moyle)** then asked the student council about their general thoughts about Rigby Hall School, positive or negative. Student Council all said that the school is a good place to be and are enjoying their time here. **(HW / CH)** did indicate that break and lunch times were proving to be a problem, especially with the behaviour, with too much play fighting, inappropriate language and a general bad feeling. **(HW)** also indicated that lunchtime in the hall had become a better atmosphere due to the tutor group sitting together. **(SB)** liked to sit with her tutor group as it gave her a chance to speak to her tutor group, socially.

Design & Technology Classroom (Room 16).

(**Student council**) asked of the possibility of more teachers eating their food in the hall. (**Mrs Rainbow**) indicated that there are 3 teaching assistants already in the hall and 4.1 / 4.2 / 4.3 tutors were already eating with their tutor groups, and this helped. (**Student council**) asked if the management could clarify the teacher / TA rotas as it was indicated that some tutors are not in the hall.

(**Mr Moyle**) could not fully explain the rota and the cost implication of lunchtimes, and the (**Student council**) also said they would like to offer suggestions on how more staff could be visible at break / lunchtimes.

(**Mr Moyle**) asked how the student council felt about the toilets as it was a concern that was indicated last year, (**HW**) thought the cleanliness of the toilets had improved which was good.

(**SB / GB**) questioned about the uniform as some students were not wearing the correct items, trainers being worn, some students had the wrong tops and even the wrong colour polo shirts. (**Mr Moyle**) explained that no one could give a definite reason for the uniform situation but perhaps the student council should research the numbers of students who are not wearing the correct uniform and pass the results on to the head teacher Mrs Smith. (**Mr Moyle**) did indicate that if the student council are to research this problem then they shouldn't make the students feel uneasy. (**Mr Moyle**) agreed to create a tally sheet for each tutor group as a simple way to collate the information.

(**HW**) asked if Rigby Subway could begin again on Fridays as it proved a successful idea and offered the students a fresh alternative to hot dinners and especially as the weather was beginning to improve.

Mr Moyle asked student council if they would like to include ECO School into the council and they all agreed to give it a try and it was during this conversation that the student council asked about using recycled plastic cups at the drinking fountains or the school could purchase water bottles for upper school so pupils would use these instead of the cups. The bottles wouldn't be taken home.

(**Mr Moyle**) said he would investigate / compare the cost of supplying water bottles to all the students against a year's supply of white drinking cups, to see if it was a cost effective solution and also the cleanliness of the water fountain areas, especially around upper school.

(**Mr Moyle**) thanked the (**Student council**) for their ideas and asked if they could meet next Monday with (**Mrs Rainbow**) taking charge of the meeting and would give each council member a tally sheet to collate the information.

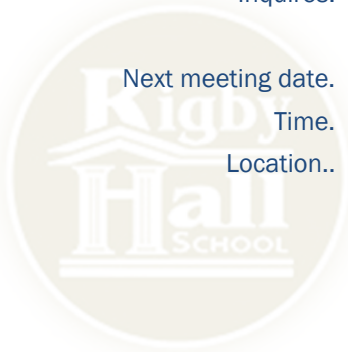

Welcome and introduction.

**Mr Moyle** introduced **Polly Kesterton 3.1** to the student council and explained to them that she is now part of the committee. (**Mr Moyle**) then asked (**PK**) her thoughts on Rigby Hall School as she is generally new to the school. (**PK**) told student council that Rigby Hall School is good and you don't get shouted at by the teachers or teaching assistants. The only negative aspect was the constant play fighting on the playground. (**PK**) also asked if activities could be put on when there is a wet or ice (the ground on the playground is slippery) break. (**Student council**) wondered about the possibility of having more a covered area so pupils could go out even when the ground is wet or icy.

(**Mr Moyle**) asked about the litter at break times, (**CH / DH**) said that the litter was bad in the morning break. The types of litter dropped was empty crisps packets, chocolate wrappers and empty milk cartons. (**CH**) said that the grass area in the undercroft is bad and the corner of the upper playground (*opposite post 16*). (**Student council**) wondered about the possibility of repositioning the bins on the playground. (**GB**) highlighted that the water fountain on a Monday is bad, (**Mrs Rainbow**) said this could be because of the PE lessons and the need of water.

(**Student council**) indicated that the sinks near **3.1** were constantly wet around the sides of each sink as pupils are splashing water everywhere and some pupils are just playing with water though they did except that the area is well used by all pupils.
