We spend a lot of time instilling in our children that they are very much an equal part in the world, that they 'can' achieve in life and they 'can' in many various forms 'work' when they leave us. Life beyond school, and work, involves adhering to certain rules and regulations, which may involve wearing a uniform, so we need to ensure that this standard and expectation is achieved within school and the children learn this as part of their overall education.

Thank you all for being courteous with your parking around school. I fully appreciate the difficulties with this and we, as with every other school around the country have the same issues. We are very close to a middle school and with timings of the school day, there are some pinch points. Please can I request that you continue to drop off and collect as swiftly as possible so that we don't cause congestion. Can I also remind you not to block any of our neighbour's driveways. We have a good relationship with the neighbours and are aware of their different circumstances and the need for their access to be clear at all times. There is no excuse to block anyone's driveway so I thank you for your respect and support with this.
