Maths – Number – counting in 2’s, 5’s and 10’s, addition, subtraction and comparing weights.

Geography – Comparison of where we live to other countries. Finding out about lives of children in another country.

ICT – Programming and algorithms Create and debug simple programs

PE – Dance.

RE – Why did people believe that Jesus was the Messiah.

Art – Explore the art work – ‘Tiger in a tropical storm’, create whole class display exploring textures.

Science – Living things and their habitats – classification, identify and name living things in local and wider environment, dangers with environmental changes to living things (zoo conservation).
