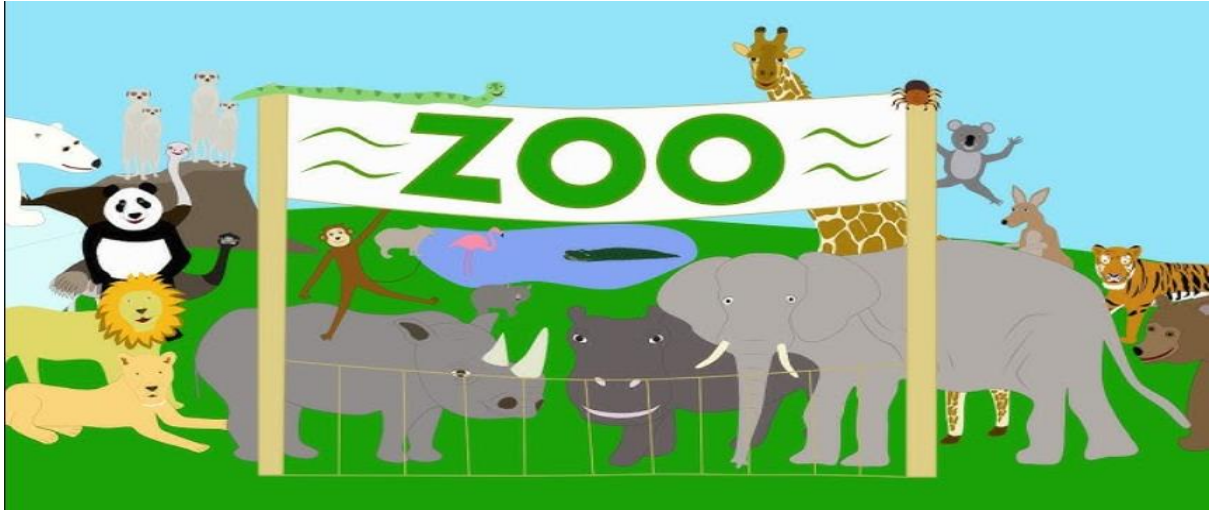


Summer Newsletter – Beech class

English – Daily communication sessions and phonics. Talk for writing and exploring stories from other cultures.

Maths – Number and weight.

Computing – Programming and algorithms.

Forest school – Being safe in the forest, scavenger hunts, bug hotels.
