### **After School Club**

Apologies for the delay, but we are now pleased to offer an after school club for Post 16 on Mondays until 4.45pm starting on September 21<sup>st</sup>. A separate letter of interest has been sent out for pupils who would like to attend.

### **Uniform**

Post 16 students aren't required to wear the standard Rigby Hall uniform. However, we do expect them to wear smart clothing with no jeans please (except on Dress Down Fridays).

### **PE**

With the change to the Government's and Department for Education Coronavirus guidance, we have updated how things operate in school. The young people are now allowed to get changed in school using the changing rooms. Therefore, we ask if on PE days students bring in their kit to change into. If your young person is uncomfortable doing this, they are able to use the toilets to change in private.
