English – In English we are looking at instructions, so far we have made a jam sandwich but will be looking at how we make toast next week.

Maths – We have started this year by looking at numbers and recognising quantities. We will also be looking at position and direction as well as capacity.

Geography – In Geography we are looking at how the land is used and when we grow different fruit and vegetables. We will also be looking at what fruit and vegetables we get from other countries.

ICT – In ICT we are looking at what a computer is and how we can stay safe on the internet.
