



## Sapling Spring 2 Newsletter

This half term we will be basing our learning around 'colour'. In our Literacy work, we will be focusing upon rhythm and rhyme, as well as some instruction work. We will be enjoying songs and rhymes based on colour, including 'I can sing a rainbow', 'Little Green Frog' and 'Little Red Tractor'. We will also be exploring rhyming stories, including Brown Bear, Brown Bear and Colour Me Happy. To link our learning on Easter to our Literacy, we will be exploring instructions, including following instructions to find different coloured Easter Eggs, as well as having a go at using symbols to give someone an instruction.

In Maths we are learning to sort objects by different categories as well as develop our knowledge of patterns. In Understanding the World we will be finding out what colours there are in the natural environment and also our school environment. We will also be exploring animal patterns, linking to the story Brown Bear, Brown Bear.

In our Personal, Social and Emotional Development we will be continuing with our play skills and asking for help when needed.

In other areas of learning we will be continuing with our skills in Games, developing our throwing, catching and kicking skills. In Art we will be exploring colour through lots of different activities, including finding out what happens when we mix colours.

PE will be on a Wednesday. Please make sure your child has PE kit in school on this day. We will keep PE kits in school and return at the end of this half term. The children are doing well with the independent dressing skills!
