Our topic this half term is Wonderful Worcestershire

What we are learning this half-term

In English, we will be learning about newspaper reports and fact files. We will exploring, a range of newspapers and identifying where the title is and what information is put into a newspaper. We will also be learning about non-fiction texts and how this differs from fiction. In Maths, we will be looking at properties of shapes, size and length. We will be exploring a variety of 2D and 3D shapes and comparing the length. We will also learn the comparative language and how measure objects accordingly.

As part of our topic we will be looking at maps of our local area, we will be exploring different photographs and looking at different geographical features.
