This half term in Lime we will be covering the following AQA units of work based upon the theme of Perfect Planet:

English: Exploring the stories 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and 'The Hungry Caterpillar' in order to create a story of their own.

Maths: Time - the different ways time is measured and beginning to tell time to o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past.

Science: Chemistry in our world, observing a number of different experiments.

Religious Education: The lead up to Easter including Palm Sunday, the Garden of Gethsemane, The last Supper and learning about the Easter story.

Food Technology: Making different dishes with potatoes: potato scones, cottage pie, bubble and squeak and potato and spring onion cakes.

Outdoor Education: Exploring and studying the countryside and local park including a visit to Sanders Park.

PSHE: Learning about legal and illegal drugs including tobacco, alcohol, different medicines and their physical and psychological risks.

Computing: Collecting data and creating tree diagrams, Venn diagrams and block graphs.

Art: Studying the work of Seurat, Monet and Picasso, creating work in their different styles.

Preparing for adulthood: Sex Education – looking at adolescence and how our feelings and bodies change as we get older.

Physical Education: Tennis.

Life Skills Challenge: Gardening, including a trip to the garden centre and looking at a variety of different jobs.
