

In Maths, we are going to sequence familiar events and daily routines using pictures and symbols. We will be sequencing events such as going to Forest School and making a jam sandwich. Then we will move into exploring sand timers and digital timers before looking at the clock face to tell the time to the hour.

As a part of the Amazing Machines topic we will be creating our own roly poly machines in DT, exploring joining the an axel to a wheel and creating our own designs and testing how well it rolls. In Science we will be exploring and naming different materials such as wood, glass, metal, paper and plastic and exploring their uses. In Computing we will be searching on the internet with adult support and exploring how stories are presented in a variety of digital ways. In History, we will be exploring how transport had changed over time and compring early transport to modern day transport. ******
